**Brad Delosa (AUS), world champion, has beaten the five time former champion Jason Wynyard (NZL) at the STIHL TIMBERSPORTS Champions Trophy on Saturday night. The world's best sport lumberjacks from three continents and eight countries competed in the historic and picturesque Lions court of the old Buda Castle, Budapest, Hungary.**

The Australian winner even broke the one-minute mark and executed the four skill-sets in only 59.25 seconds, establishing a new world-record. Maori Jason Wynyard (1:02.10) got easily to the big final round, but his boundless energy was not enough to stop Brad Delosa as the Australian shattered the one minute barrier. Third place went to the Canadian Mitch Hewitt (1:11.06). The best-placed European, Martin Komarek from the Czech Republic, finished in fourth place (1:11.96). The Hungarian István Juhász, the oldest participant who only joined the sport three years ago at the age of 45, got the loudest cheer from the audience, but ended up back in the 8th place.

It is the first time the Stihl Timbersports Champions Trophy competition took place in Hungary. István Juhász, who qualified among the eight best athletes last year, is making this sport more popular in his home country, where a crowd of thousands turned out to support the athletes.

The Stihl Timbersports Champions Trophy competition will continue to be held around the world with this season concluding at the World Championship in Innsbruck, Austria in November.

The disciplines: Standing Block (competitors must chop through a vertical block with an axe), Underhand Chop (competitors must chop through a horizontal block with an axe), Springboard (competitors must chop two pockets into a vertical pole, place springboards into these pockets and, standing on the top springboard at a height of 2.80 metres, chop through the log at the top of the pole), Stihl Stock Saw (competitors must cut two slices off a log, using a downward motion followed by an upward motion), Single Buck (competitors slice through a 46cm log using a 2m single man cross-cut saw), Hot Saw (competitors cut

three slices off a log using special chainsaws with over 60 horsepower weighing almost 30kg and with chain speeds of up to 260km/h)
